Parade Information and Rules

- Entry Fee:** **NO ENTRY FEE / MUST REGISTER TO ENTER**
EMERGENCY VEHICLES LIMITED TO 1 VEHICLE PER ENTRY!
Last Day to Enter – Monday, December 12, 2016
- Cash prizes:** "Most Creative" Entry - First \$125, Second \$100, Third \$75
- Pre-registration:** **ALL Entries must pre-register by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, December 12th.**
- Parade check in:** Jaycee Park 4:00-5:30 p.m. (Nave Street) Please see enclosed map.
- *ALL Entries Must Be Decorated for Christmas***
- Parade Santa:** Parade Santa will be **ONLY** Santa in the parade – Please!
- Restrictions:** Entries must be no taller than 13' and no longer than 26'
- Candy:** **FOR SAFETY REASONS, PLEASE ASK YOUR GROUP TO BE CAREFUL IN DISTRIBUTING CANDY TO PARADE WATCHERS!**
Santa's float always provides candy for the children.
- Horses:** Must have on a diaper or bag or someone walking to scoop.
(All animals) **City Ordinance requires owners to pick up after their pets.**
- Drivers:** **ALL drivers must be 16 years of age with a valid TN driver's license.**
Vehicle must be "street legal". NO ATVs. STRICTLY ENFORCED!

Thank you for participating in **Clinton's "Once Upon A Christmas" Parade.**

The Parade will begin at **6:00 p.m. Saturday, December 17**. All floats, cars, and emergency vehicles must enter at Jaycee Park.

In order to alleviate traffic bottlenecks, we have designated areas for each type of entry. The map on the back shows areas of staging to complete decorating, wait on the rest of your group, etc. **Registration and check-in for your designated area will begin at 4:00 p.m., where you will be assigned a number.** Volunteers will then direct you out of the park and down Nave Street to Eagle Bend Road and on toward the Real Dry Cleaner's location. We appreciate your cooperation.

Cars, Pickup Trucks & Motorcycles – All vehicles must be "street legal" and the driver must have a valid driver's license. No ATVs. No skateboards. No bicycles. No exceptions!

Emergency Vehicles/Tow Trucks/Military Vehicles – Please line up on Christin Drive. Please enter from Field Drive. A volunteer will be there to check you in. **ONLY ONE VEHICLE PER ENTRY!!!**

Floats – any vehicle pulling a trailer, etc. (limit 26' trailer)

Horses – please check-in at 5:00 p.m. Please park at the riding arena on Field Drive. There will be a volunteer in your area to check you in. You will then proceed down Christin Drive and will be fed into the parade.

***Horses are required to wear a diaper or have someone to scoop poop. A violation may result in a citation to court.**

Riding & Walking groups PLEASE PARK in the Municipal Parking lot and then meet across from Real Dry Cleaners. Walking groups will be fed into the parade. Riding groups may walk back to load onto their float.


The parade ends behind the Clinton Community Center. All entries that need to unload passengers and secure items on the float before leaving the parade area are requested to pull into the designated parking area. Please make arrangements to pick up walking groups, etc. Horses will need to have someone bring their trailer to the recycling center lot behind the Community Center.

*** ALL ENTRIES WITH ANIMALS – Pet owners are required by City Ordinance to "remove animal waste". A violation may result in a citation to court.**
