Students wishing to participate will return their completed application form with a parent's signature and a letter of recommendation from a current teacher to their guidance counselor. The forms will be submitted to the Youth Leadership Anderson County Board for the selection process.

## **Required Qualifications:**

- Student must be an upcoming high school sophomore, junior or senior to apply
- Application must include a letter of recommendation from a current class teacher
- Meet during the school day (time to be determined by advisor)
- Participants must comply with the Anderson County Schools Student Code of Conduct

## **General Information:**

- Applications may be submitted by May 12, 2017
- Selection Process Participants will be selected based on their application, teacher's recommendation, grades, attendance and behavior. The selected candidates will be notified by mail of acceptance into the program in August 2017.
- **Program Cost** \$70 per student to be paid prior to the first session (Orientation) in August. Only paid students will be allowed to attend.
- **Assistance** Limited need-based fee assistance awards available. Student's written request must include a current teacher recommendation letter and be submitted to the YLAC Board of Directors.
- **Program Schedule** six monthly full-day sessions from August through March (subject to change). No session will be held in October or December.
- Required Sessions Orientation/Team Building and State Government Trip to Nashville.
- Graduation Ceremony Scheduled for April (subject to change).
- Absenteeism Students with more than two (2) excused absences from the monthly sessions will not graduate from the YLAC program
- Adult Supervision A male and a female Program Director will facilitate each session. A minimum of three adults will chaperone the State Government trip to Nashville.
